TNIU's ACM degree program provides foundational training for a variety of ministry opportunities and is a stepping stone for the BTh program.

TNIU's BTh degree program provides students with vocational training and solid grounding in Bible Theology, Doctrine, and Ministry Practices. It also prepares students with the necessary requirements for entering a vigorous Masters program.\*

- Theology Courses (45 Semester Credits)
- Practicum (9 Semester Credits)

TNIU's MTh degree program is designed to equip believers for practical ministry in the local church and other ministry settings.\*\*

- Ministry Studies (15 Semester Credits)

TNIU's MDiv degree program integrates Biblical, Theological, Historical, and Ministry Practices with supervised ministry experience. The program is designed to equip candidates for full-time vocational ministry as pastors, chaplains, missionaries, church associates, and para-church leaders.\*\*

- Electives (9 Semester Credits)

TNIU's DMin degree program is designed for those currently engaged in ministry, who are seeking to enhance professional competence, to obtain personal and spiritual growth, and to stimulate growth in ministry.

The DCL degree program is created for Christian leaders, typically serving outside the Church, the opportunity to grow in leadership, communication, structure, team building and cultural understanding.

Both programs anticipate that students will remain fully employed while engaged in the learning process.\*\*\*
